



## Rules & General Information

**If you are unable to make your class please let your instructor know via text message 07974 946238.**

Try to be considerate at all times. We would like to try and maintain a safe and happy environment that people and dogs can enjoy.

All members are responsible for the safety of their dogs, themselves and other people. Please ensure that they are not a nuisance to other dogs or members or horses that are on site.

Not all dogs may be as willing to socialise as yours so please respect other dogs' space. Please don't get offended if someone moves their dog away if they need a quiet area.

Rule & Good Practice- these points will enable the smooth running of our training sessions.

Members should respect the training venue - any dog waste should be taken off site for disposal.

All members should be prepared to help with setting up or tidying away equipment. i.e: 6pm session- please arrive at 5.30pm and be prepared to set up, and the last classes should help with packing down.

Only run your dog if it is fit and healthy. Do not bring your dog if you know it has been in contact with another dog with a contagious disease. Please do not bring bitches if in season. Only bring yourself if you are also fit and well- nobody else wants to share your flu or tummy upset!

Remember this is also a learning environment so pay attention to the trainer and try to keep noise levels down so other people can hear what is being taught. Be ready to run with your dog to minimise delays. We ask everyone can help to pole pick or change fence heights in order to maximise your class time.

Keep dogs on leads when not running.

Places are secured by paying for an 8 week term, fees cannot be refunded for missing classes or holidays.

Do not let your dog urinate on the equipment, it is very distracting for other dogs and they will all want to mark it. (If they do mark, then ask for the disinfectant and wash the area down)

Please be considerate to our neighbours and try to keep barking to a minimum where ever possible.

Suitable clothing and footwear should be worn.

Please note the following in order to make life at our training sessions fun and enjoyable for everyone (and their dogs!). Please try to leave all "baggage" at the door just for an hour :-). Chill and be ready to have fun with your dog and feel ready to learn! Remember this is fun and supposed to be how we relax and enjoy our time with our dogs.
